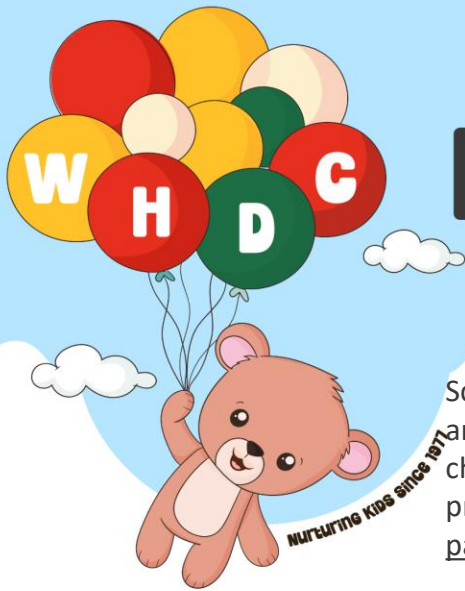

Canora Activities: This Month's Learning Adventure: "Weather Wonders"

Week 1: November 3–7 – "Weather Watchers"
